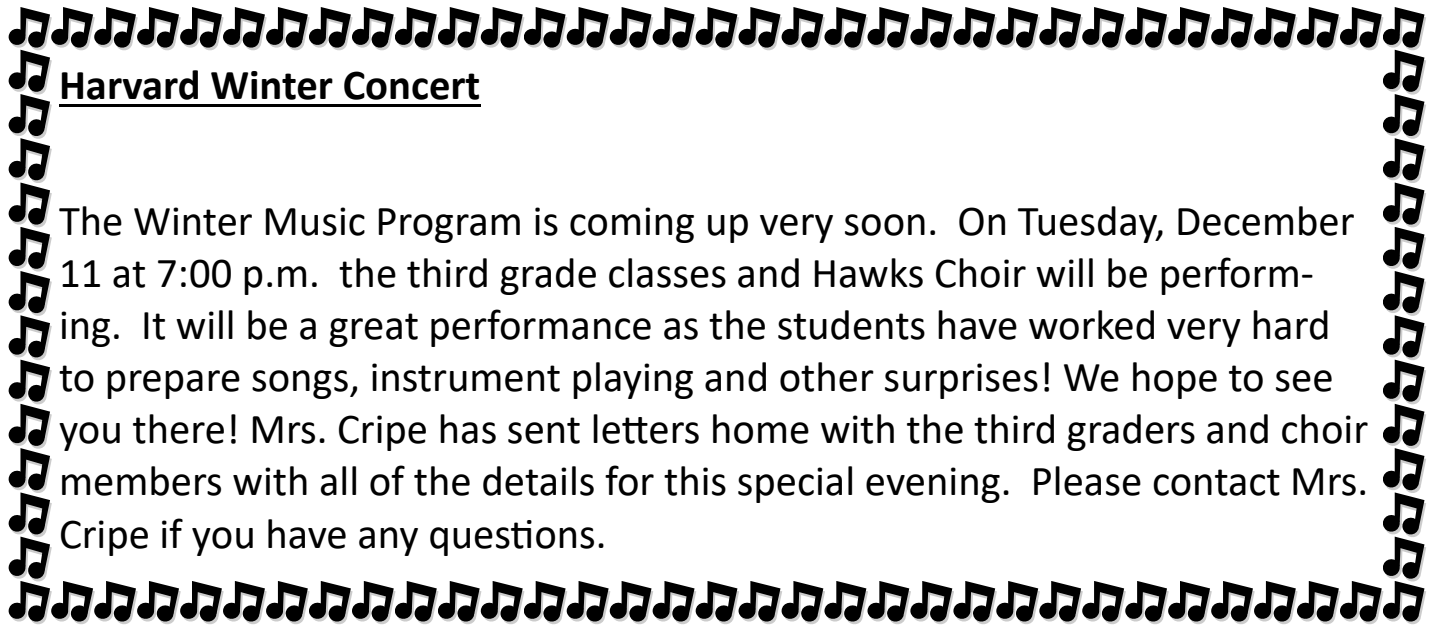

Attendance Matters

Daily attendance is one of the most powerful predictors of school success and on-time graduation our goal is to have every student at school on-time every day.

Missing 10% (2 days a month) of the school year is considered chronically absent.

Being late to school may lead to lack of academic progress.

After 3 unexcused absences in a 30-day period or 10 unexcused absences within the school year, we are required to file a petition with juvenile court.

If a student missed 7 days of school during a school year, our district requires a 3rd party documentation to excuse all future absences and early dismissals.
